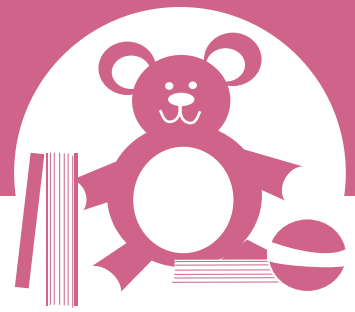

INSTRUCTIONS:

*An assumption is made that the topic of Childcare is being done concomitant with a larger chapter on Families or Raising Children. This review board game covers some of the topics from the Newcomers' Guide Childcare chapter, as well as general information and idiomatic expressions pertaining to children and families.

REQUIRED STRUCTURES: explaining vocabulary, telling an anecdote/retelling a story, giving an opinion

REQUIRED VOCABULARY: general game vocabulary: *your turn, miss a turn, roll the die, go back, up the ladder, toddler, suspect, child abuse, role model, temper tantrum, teenager, part-time job, nap, community group, "latch-key" kid, average, babysitter, allowance, curfew, kindergarten, parenting style, discipline, hopes*
