

INSTRUCTIONS:

10 vocabulary words are to be matched with their clue and word stress pattern on a chart. Each syllable has a dot, and the stressed syllable has the larger dot for emphasis. Students should be encouraged to say the words out loud to help determine the appropriate pattern.

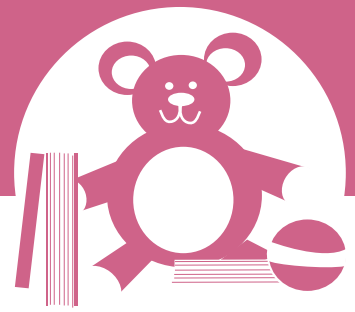
