## 4-WAY STOP



### INSTRUCTION SHEET

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

As the 4-way stop configuration is not familiar to many newcomers, this is a no-language practice activity suitable for groups at any level. In a large, open area, mark out an “intersection” on the floor with masking or coloured tape as per below. Review hand signals and road signs with students, as well as rules of the road regarding 4 way stops (Refer to Safe Driving Guide p. 43). Distribute intersection instruction cards and divide students amongst “traffic lanes”. Have students proceed in order as per their cards’ instructions and road etiquette, using hand signals in lieu of car turning signals.

#### REQUIRED STRUCTURES:

**REQUIRED VOCABULARY:** *intersection, turning signal, hand signal, right-of-way, yield, complete stop, straight (through)*

**GROUP SIZE:** large group (whole class or two classes together)

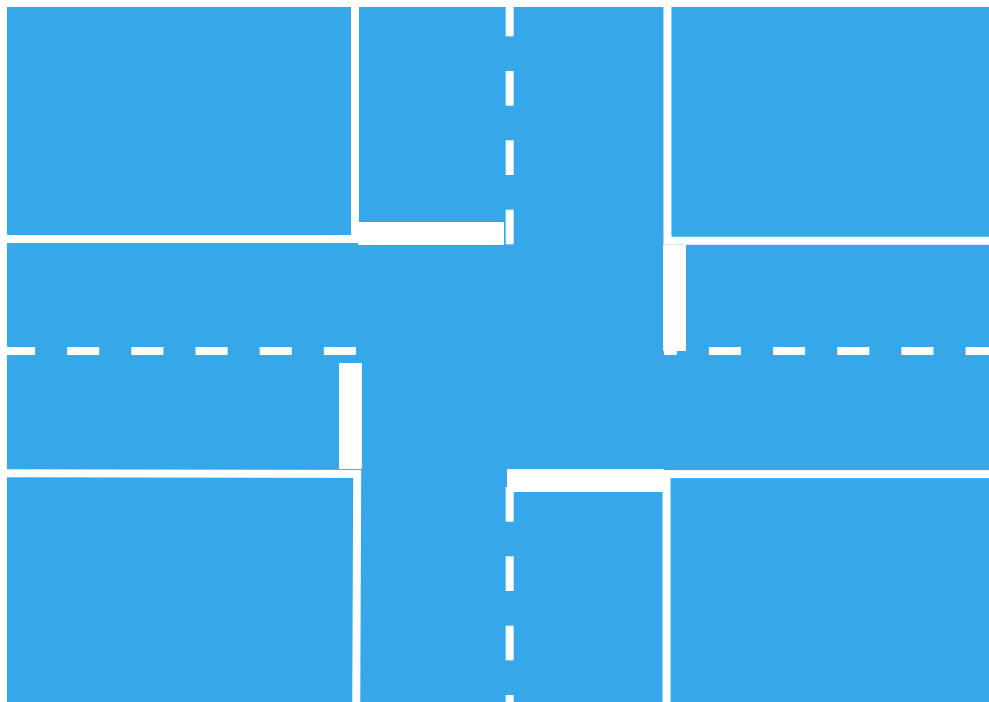
**HANDOUTS:** intersection instruction cards (one per student)

**OTHER MATERIALS REQUIRED:** masking tape for floor, ICBC RoadSense Safe Driving Guide for reference (p. 43)

**RELATED GRAMMAR:** none

#### FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES:

- MARK OUT THE INTERSECTION BELOW ONTO THE FLOOR WITH MASKING TAPE
