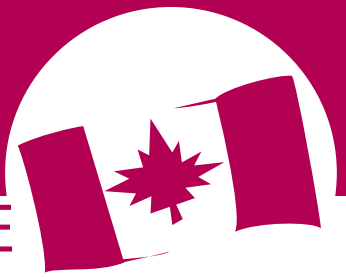

GROUP SIZE: individual or pairs

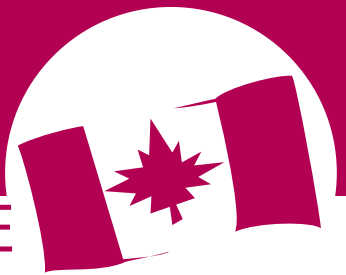

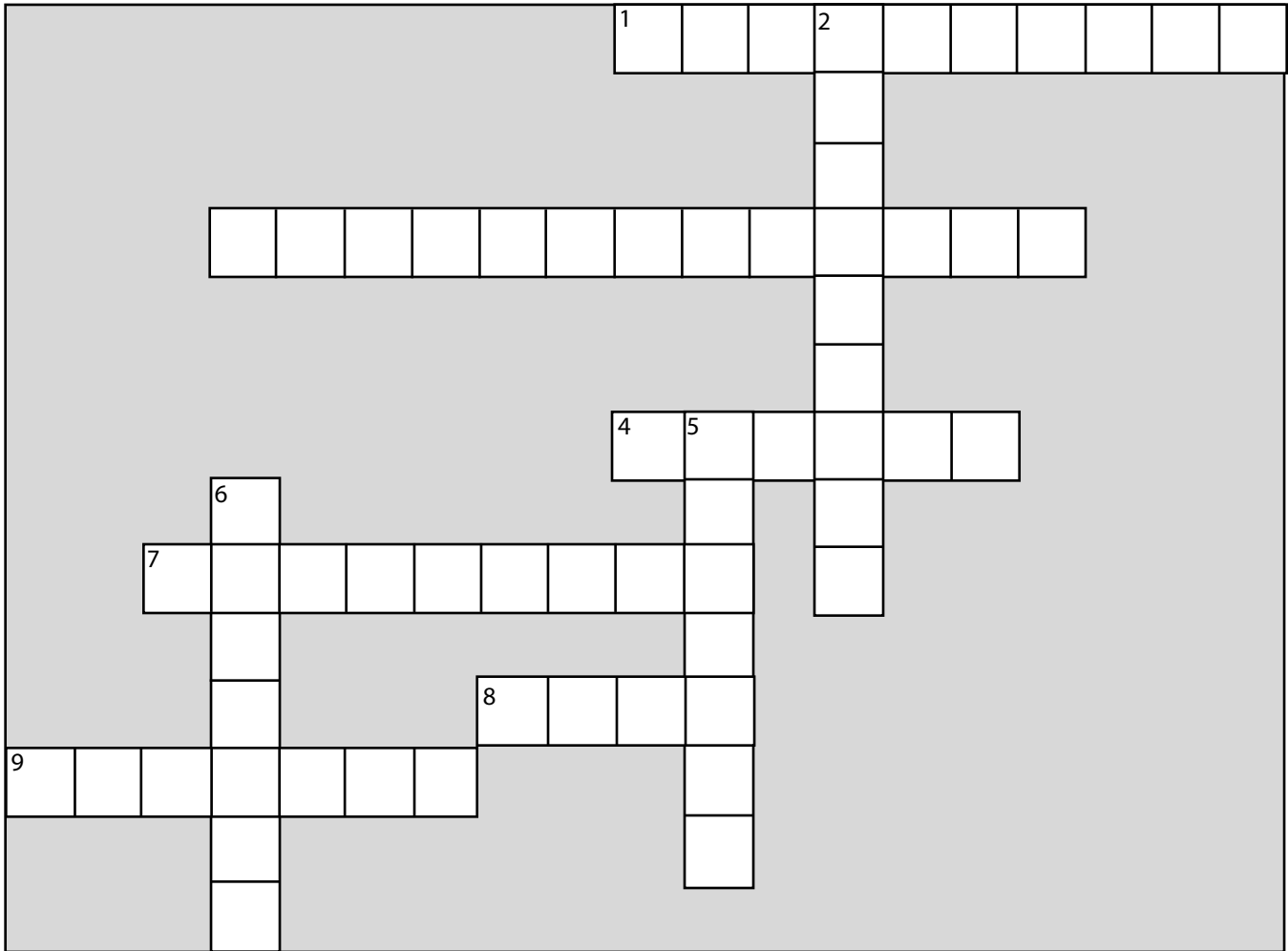
